WHAT WE ARE NOT

We are not a program provider or a travel agency. We are an information bridge: we show alumni which international programs accept the Segal Education Award and how to apply that funding. We never charge alumni, programs, or commissions.

How the Education Award works abroad

Four steps from end of service to boarding pass. Use this as a slide or a handout in exit interviews.

1

Finish your term
Complete AmeriCorps service and earn the Segal Education Award.

2

Explore placements
Browse destinations on pathwaysabroad.org/explore or ask the Pathfinder tool.

3

Enroll for credit
Register through an accredited Title IV school so the award can be applied.

4

Deploy your award
The school disburses funds toward program, credit, and travel costs.

What the award can cover

Program and enrollment fees	Covered
Academic credit (\$999 - \$2,249)	Required
Accommodation and meals	Usually included
Flights, insurance, visa fees	Covered when billed through the school
Personal spending money	Not covered

The one rule that matters

The award is paid to an accredited Title IV school, not to the member. Enroll for credit through the school and it can bill program costs, flights, and insurance.

What your alumni can access

Pathways Abroad connects AmeriCorps alumni with international programs that accept Segal Education Award funding.

Africa & Middle East, Asia, the Caribbean, Europe, Latin America, and Oceania.

Weeks abroad

Short cohort-friendly trips through semester-length placements.

\$2,000 - \$7,395

Typical award range

Partial and full-term awards both stretch further overseas than at home.

Featured international partners

International Volunteer HQ (IVHQ)

Community service placements in 40+ destinations, from Tanzania to Portugal.

Intern Abroad HQ (IAHQ)

Career-defining internships abroad, including Japan, Greece, and Costa Rica.

NEW: PATHFINDER

Members describe what they want in plain language and Pathfinder asks a few follow-ups, then shows matching placements they can email to themselves.

Five things to say in an exit interview

Copy these into your end-of-service checklist or read them straight off the page.

01

Lead with the deadline

Awards expire seven years after service ends. Name the date.

02

Name a real number

A full award is \$7,395; partial terms are often \$2,000 to \$4,500.

03

Correct the flight myth

Billed through a Title IV school, the award can cover airfare, insurance, and visa fees.

04

Make it concrete

Four weeks of wildlife conservation in South Africa, housing and meals included.

05

Give one next step

Send them to pathwaysabroad.org/explore or to a Tuesday session.

Ready-to-share resources

Everything here is free for AmeriCorps programs, commissions, and alumni networks.

01

This toolkit

Forward the PDF (or edit the PowerPoint) for program managers and advisors.

02

Award checklist

A 3-page alumni checklist covering balances, expiry, credit, and costs.

03

Custom planning guide

Members request a personalized budget and timeline sheet by email.

04

Explore + Pathfinder

pathwaysabroad.org/explore: filter by region, focus, length, and cost.

05

Explainer video

A short video on how the Segal Education Award works abroad.

06

Alumni stories

Real member stories by country, plus a form for your alumni to submit theirs.

07

Newsletter copy

Paste-ready blocks for program and alumni newsletters.

08

Social posts

Suggested captions for Instagram, LinkedIn, and program channels.
